

Multitude of Voyces Monetary Donations Policy

The charity depends on the generosity of private individuals to support its charitable aims and is grateful for monetary donations of any size.

This Policy relates only to donations made by private individuals to the charity, donating their own money and without consequent obligation by the charity to that individual.

Donations to the charity are non-returnable and are independent of any other financial obligations of the donor to the charity or of the charity to that donor.

Donations may be made directly to the charity via the Charities Aid Foundation or via any of the alternative methods of payment offered by the charity. Gift Aid can be applied where appropriate. The charity cannot take responsibility for any Gift Aid wrongly assigned to it.

Please note where donors may be subject to banking or currency exchange fees these cannot be reimbursed by the charity.

Donors may request invoices and receipts for their own records or tax purposes.

Donors will only be named by the charity with their express permission, for example within fundraising materials/marketing materials/media and social media articles/reports.

Donations will be clearly registered on the charity's finance software and details will be made available in full to the charity's Trustees, independent accountant, formal advisors and statutory bodies as required.

Donors may be subject to money-laundering checks if appropriate and strictly necessary.

The charity is currently applying for accreditation with the Fundraising Regulator.
